Gifts to the Schools

The Board of Education is receptive to gifts which enhance and extend the educational process in the schools.

Individuals or organizations wishing to present gifts to the schools should consult with the superintendent or designee regarding the proposed gifts.

Any limitations or conditions on the use of the proposed gift should be set forth by the donor as part of a written gift proposal. The superintendent will review all gift proposals and forward them to the Board of Education for consideration by the board for action. The Board of Education reserves the right to accept or decline any proposed gifts. In deciding whether or not to accept gifts, the Board of Education will consider whether or not they need meet any statutory requirements which apply.

It is the policy of the district that textbooks, books, periodicals and similar matter will be purchased through the regular channels of administration subject to final approval of the board. However, library books, or the funds for such, may be donated by Parent Teacher Associations to a classroom or the school library with the advice of the classroom teacher and/or the school librarian and approval by the building principal.

All gifts accepted by the Board of Education become the property of the district and are subject to the same controls and regulations that govern other school-owned property.
