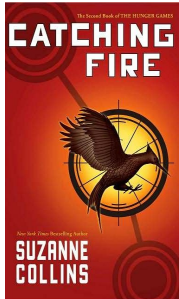

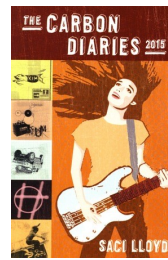

from a serious accident and suffering from memory lapses, learns a startling secret about her existence.

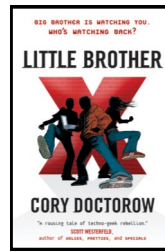


The Carbon Diaries 2015

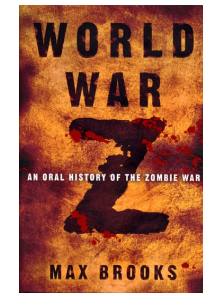
A scientist invents a time machine and travels 800,000 years into the future where he discovers humans have evolved into two groups: the Eloi and their Morlock oppressors.

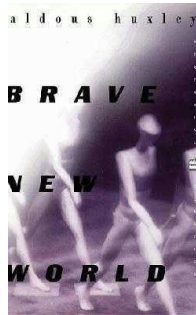

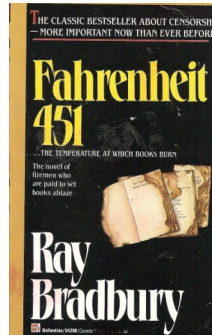

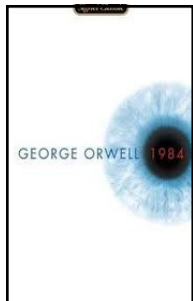
A book-burner fireman in a future fascist state finds out books are a vital part of a culture he never knew. He clandestinely pursues reading, until he is betrayed.

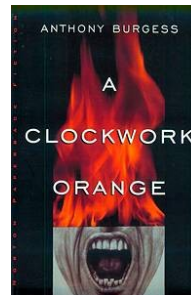

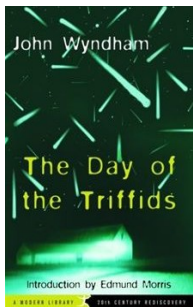
A violent teen named Alex is "rehabilitated" by the government in this satirical view of the future of the industrialized world.

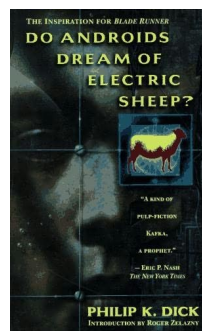

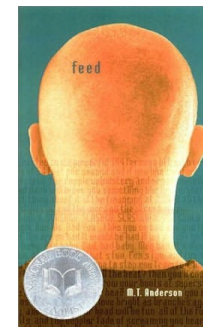
