The Hicksville Public School
District now utilizes a notification
system, called SchoolMessenger,
to broadcast all school closings,
delays, and emergencies to
families who have students
enrolled in the district.
SchoolMessenger is also
used by each school to send
non-emergency messages, such
as daily updates, reminders, and
event announcements.

SchoolMessenger utilizes the family information stored on file to send automated phone calls, SMS text messages, and email messages. Most messages from SchoolMessenger are sent via

email and/or text. In emergency situations and school closings, messages are sent via email, text, and phone call.

SchoolMessenger will not replace current school communication methods.
The District's implementation of SchoolMessenger is intended to extend its commitment to remain personally connected with parents by offering additional and timely communications.
