Your child will be taking very important **New York State Regents Examinations** in June. These tests are rigorous and must be passed by all students who want to fulfill their requirements for a Regents endorsed or local diploma for **graduation**.

Because the tests are so important, we are instituting a special after school Regents Preparation Program so every student will have the opportunity to perform at his/her highest academic level. These sessions are in addition to each teacher's regularly scheduled extra-help. The program will begin as early as March 21st for some classes and the week of March 27th for others; students should check with their teachers. The classes will meet twice a week for a total of 18 sessions. Each session will meet for one hour beginning at 2:30 p.m. Please see the reverse side of this letter which contains the schedule for each course offered.

Attendance is **strongly recommended** for all students. We urge you to encourage your child to participate. **Attendance will be taken at each session.**
