WHEREAS, pursuant to 6 NYCRR §§617.5(c)(9) and (10), the "construction or expansion of a primary or accessory/appurtenant, nonresidential structure or facility involving less than 4,000 square feet of gross floor area and not involving a change in zoning or a use variance and consistent with local land use controls, but not radio communication or microwave transmission facilities;" and/or "routine activities of educational institutions, including expansion of existing facilities by less than 10,000 square feet of gross floor area and school closings, but not changes in use related to such closings" are Type II actions;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education, after review of the proposed action and 6 NYCRR §617.5, hereby determines that the proposed projects are Type II Actions pursuant to 6 NYCRR §§617.5 (c)(9) and (10) of the implementing regulations of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, and will, therefore, by definition, have no significant adverse impact on the environment.

**BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Board of Education of the Hicksville Union Free School District hereby authorizes the following proposition to be placed on the ballot at the Annual Budget Vote and Election on May 21, 2024, and for said proposition to be included in the Annual Notice of said Vote and Election:

#### Proposition No. 2

In the event the voters approve the District Budget contained at PROPOSITION NO. 1 above, shall the sum of \$60,000 be appropriated to the Hicksville Gregory Museum for educational services associated with its programs and a tax be levied on the taxable property of the District in that amount?
